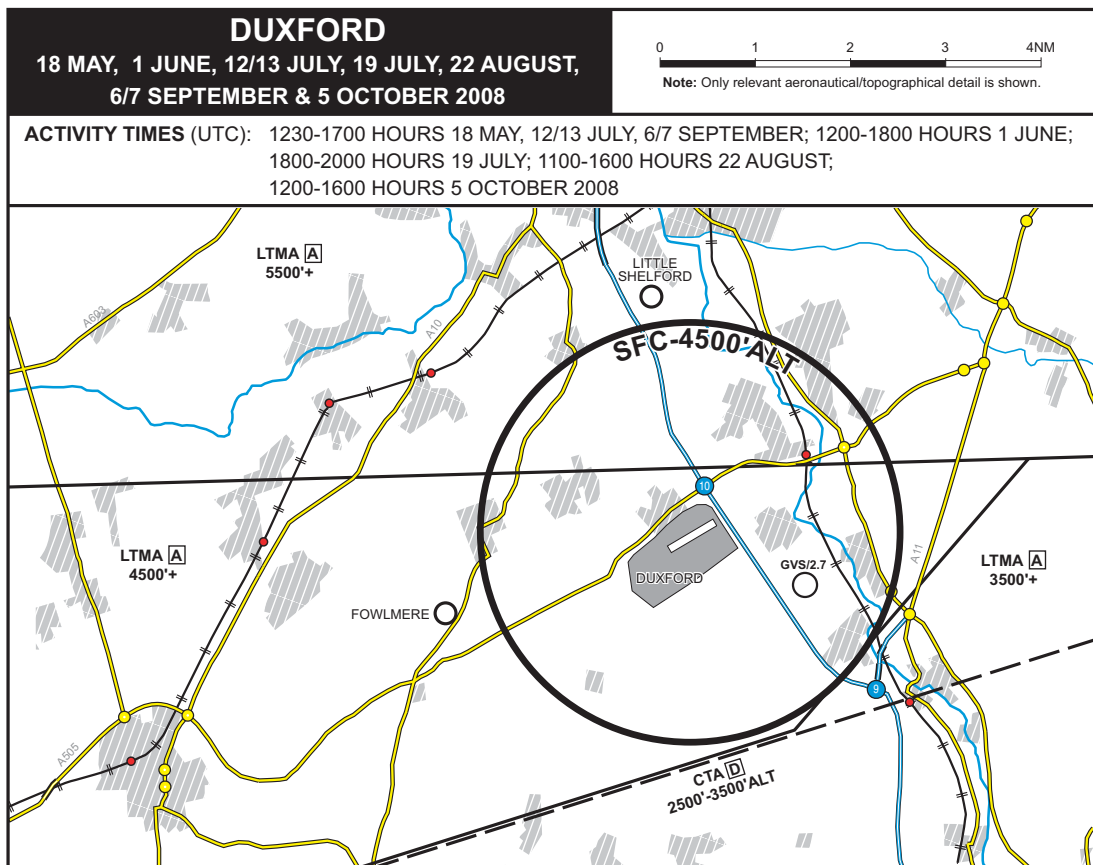

RESTRICTION OF FLYING REGULATIONS – DUXFORD 18 MAY, 1 JUNE, 12/13 JULY, 19 JULY, 22 AUGUST, 6/7 SEPTEMBER AND 5 OCTOBER 2008

1 Air displays will be held at Duxford on the following dates, **18 May, 1 June, 12/13 July, 19 July, 22 August, 6/7 September and 5 October 2008**. On each occasion a large number of aircraft will be involved in high-energy manoeuvres; therefore the Secretary of State, for Transport has, deemed it necessary to introduce the following Restriction of Flying Regulations under Article 96 of the Air Navigation Order 2005, (military aircraft should comply with JSP552 201.135.9):

- (a) Subject to paragraph (b), between **1230 and 1700 on 18 May, and between 1200 and 1800 on 1 June, and between 1230 and 1700 on 12/13 July, and between 1800 and 2000 on 19 July, and between 1100 and 1600 on 22 August, and between 1230 and 1700 on 6/7 September, and between 1200 and 1600 on 5 October 2008**, no aircraft is to fly below 4500 ft amsl within the area of a circle having a radius of 2.2 nm whose centre is at 520527N 0000755E (Duxford).
- (b) Paragraph (a), does not apply to:
 - (i) Any aircraft flying with the prior permission of the Flying Display Director at Duxford Aerodrome; and
 - (ii) any aircraft in the service of the Chief Officer of Police for Cambridgeshire.
