UKRAINE CRISIS: CHANNEL ISLANDS AIRSPACE AND JERSEY AIRPORT RESTRICTIONS

1 Channel Island airspace restriction issued by Jersey Director of Civil Aviation

No aircraft which is owned, chartered, or operated by a person connected with Russia, or which is registered in Russia, shall fly in Channel Islands airspace, including the airspace above the Channel Island territorial sea. This regulation does not apply to any aircraft flying in accordance with the permission of the UK Secretary of State for Transport or to aircraft flying in accordance with a clearance issued by the Air Traffic Control Centre at Swanwick or Prestwick. Note: A person connected with Russia is:

- a) An individual who is ordinarily resident in Russia;
- b) An individual who is located in Russia;
- c) A person, other than an individual, which is incorporated or constituted under the law of Russia; or
- d) A person, other than an individual, which is domiciled in Russia.

2 Jersey Airport restriction issued by the Government of Jersey, Minister for External Relations and Financial Services

No aircraft which is owned, chartered or operated by a person connected with Belarus, or which is registered in Belarus, shall land at Jersey Airport. This regulation does not apply to any aircraft flying in accordance with the permission of the Government of Jersey, Minister for External Relations and Financial Services or aircraft flying in accordance with a clearance issued by Jersey Air Traffic Control.
