LONDON GATWICK AIRPORT (EGKK) - REDESIGNATION OF TAXIWAY ROMEO ALPHA AND SECTION OF TAXIWAY ROMEO

1 Introduction

Gatwick Airport Limited (GAL) is redesignating two areas of existing taxiway to provide a clearer taxiway naming convention.

1. The existing Taxiway Romeo Alpha will be redesignated to form part of **Taxiway Romeo**.
2. The existing section of Taxiway Romeo which runs diagonally north-eastwards to Taxiway Quebec will be redesignated **Taxiway Romeo Alpha**.

2 Programme & Operational Implications H24

Works will be required ahead of the redesignation to update taxiway information signs and painted pavement markings. The works and redesignation of the taxiways is due to take place in mid-August, dates and timings are subject to change and will be confirmed by NOTAM.

The redesignated sections will become effective in phases as follows:

1. Phase 1
Taxiway Romeo Alpha will be closed to allow redesignation works to take place.
2. Phase 2
The existing section of Taxiway Romeo which runs diagonally north-eastwards to Taxiway Quebec will be closed with barriers and red lights and the taxiway information signs will be updated. It will be redesignated Taxiway Romeo Alpha however it will remain closed until further notice. At a later date to be confirmed, Taxiway Romeo Alpha will open with revised signs and painted pavement markings.
3. Phase 3
The section of Taxiway Romeo (formerly Romeo Alpha) will open with revised signs and painted pavement markings.

3 Promulgation

Further information will be published in Airport Notices, NOTAMs and messages on ATIS as appropriate.

The UK AIP entry for EGKK will be updated in due course once the works have been completed.

Airlines are encouraged to confirm with their aerodrome information and chart suppliers that the changes have been updated as appropriate.

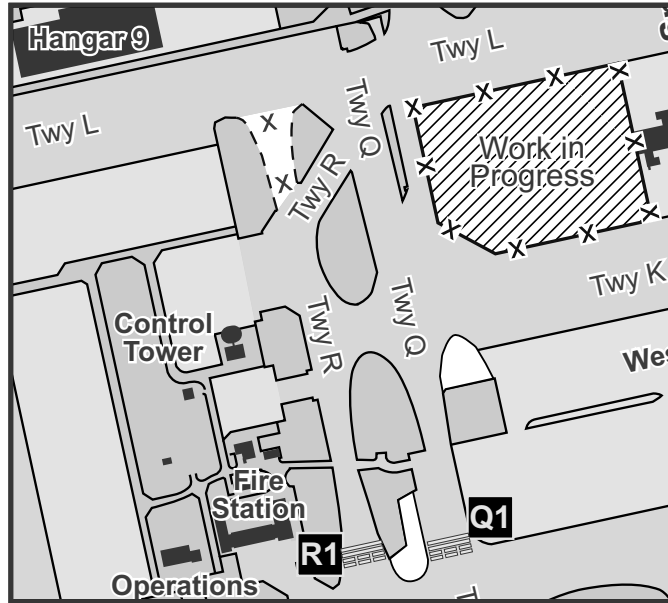

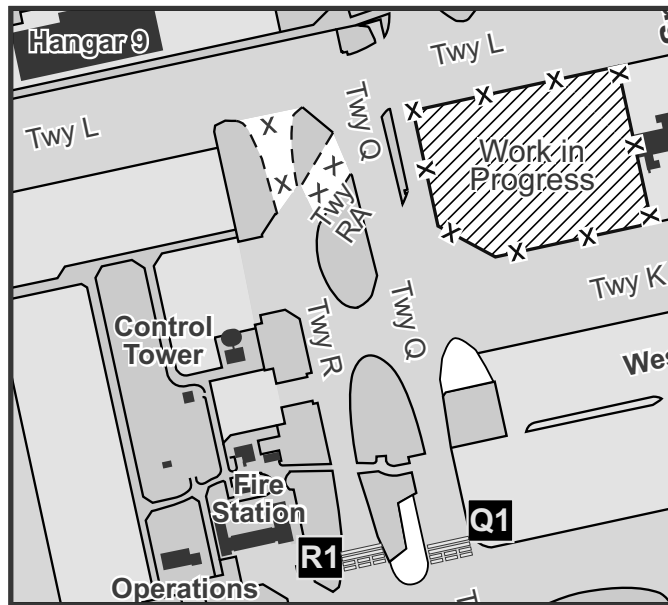
